



12 ELEMENTS OF A MERIT IMAGE

Impact is the sense one gets upon viewing an image for the first time.

Technical excellence is the print quality of the image itself as it is presented for viewing.

Creativity is the original, fresh, and external expression of the imagination of the maker by using the medium to convey an idea, message or thought.

Style is defined in a number of ways as it applies to a creative image.

Composition is important to the design of an image, bringing all of the visual elements together in concert to express the purpose of the image.

Presentation affects an image by giving it a finished look. The mats and borders used, either physical or digital, should support and enhance the image, not distract from it.

Color Balance supplies harmony to an image.

Center of Interest is the point or points on the image where the maker wants the viewer to stop as they view the image.

Lighting-the use and control of light-refers to how dimension, shape and roundness are defined in an image. **Subject Matter** should always be appropriate to the story being told in an image.

Technique is the approach used to create the image. Printing, lighting, posing, capture, presentation media, and more are part of the technique applied to an image. **Story Telling** refers to the image's ability to evoke imagination.
