**BIO:** Ken Bovat, Jr., Master Photographer, Craftsman, is the owner and sole photographer of Photo-Art by Ken Bovat in Claverack, New York.

He began his business in 1976, photographing mostly weddings and environmental portraits, working out of his home.

As his business grew, he relocated to an old railroad depot, which he converted into his current studio. His photography consists of weddings, portraits - specializing in High School Seniors, copy and restoration and a small amount of commercial photography.

Ken received his Master of Photography Degree from the Professional Photographers of America in 1988 and his Photographic Craftsman Degree in 1992. He was awarded Life Membership in 2014. In 1998, the Professional Photographers' Society of New York State awarded Ken the PPA National Award. Ken went on to serve as President of that organization in 2003-2004.

Ken is the recipient of numerous photographic awards on the local, state and international levels. He has lectured and presented photographic classes to many groups, both professional and amateur



Here are the rules...

**Image Size:** Longest dimension 4,000 pixels (20 inches at 200 ppi)

**Color Profile:** sRGB or Adobe 1998

Named as: Image Title.jpg (Sample: New York at Sunrise.jpg)

Must be exact name of Print

**Saved as:** JPG, quality 10

**Total File Size:** Not to exceed 3.5 MB

**3 Categories:** Portrait \* Weddings/Events \* Illustrative

**Max Entries:** 4 images

Images MUST have been entered in a HV Competition in 2018. <u>Changes are NOT permitted</u>. Do not use your own name in the file. Remove any keywords added to the EXIF data.

In an email, list images as follows: Last Name, First Name, TITLE, Category (no spaces after commas)
Sample: Smith, Jennifer, NEW YORK AT SUNRISE, Illustrative. Repeat on separate line, send images as attachments, follow all other rules.


