Bio: Mark's photographic career began in high school as a Staff Photographer photographing sporting events for two local newspapers in northern Indiana. He later attended Rhode Island School of Photography.

For the past 20 years, Mark has been photographing weddings, portraits and corporate events in Clifton Park, NY.

Mark holds the Master of Photography, Master Artist and Photographic Craftsman Degrees from PPA. He is a recipient of PPA's 2015 Imaging Excellence Award, 2017 Top Ten Illustrative Grand Imaging Award, and in 2019, second place Grand Imaging Award in the Artist Category as well as numerous awards from PPANE, PPSNYS, PPAM and PPARI.

A Message from Our President

As most of you already know, the future of PPSNYS is in serious doubt. Membership in the state organization has been declining for quite a few years and attendance at the state convention has also fallen off. I have attended meetings in the past several months to see how we can maintain and revive the organization. In late summer, it became clear that the state organization did not have the funds to put on a 2020 convention and it was decided to have a raffle, which many of you generously contributed to. Unfortunately, we only

received about half of the ticket sales necessary to pull off the convention. The raffle will still be held, and the cost of the prize is covered with some left over for operating expenses.

Without a convention and with continued declining enrollment in PPSNYS, the board of Hudson Valley felt that it is no longer in our members best interests to send the state the \$1000 fee to remain a PPSNYS affiliate. This was discussed with the general membership at our last meeting in October. The membership agreed and it was decided that Hudson Valley should no longer be a section of PPSNYS.

In June of 2020, PPSNYS will be 115 years old; so, it is with great sadness on all our parts to see it come to this. At this point, it does not look like PPSNYS will continue after its fiscal year ends in April of 2020. The PPSNYS Summer Workshop will continue for 2020 and probably into the future. I will keep you posted.

The good news is that our members can expect that there will be a decrease in dues now that we will no longer be a section of PPSNYS. I will be meeting with the board before our November meeting and we will be working on the dues structure as well as events going into the future. We are looking forward to a continuing and vibrant Hudson Valley Professional Photographers Society of NY.

Our November 20 meeting features the Print of the Year Competition and guest speaker Mark Sweeney. Mark will be showing us how he makes "Something out of Nothing," making images from every day, ordinary items and turning them into something competition worthy.

For the Print of the Year Competition, look over the images you have submitted during the year for Print Comp. This is not a critiqued competition. The winner of this competition in each of the categories will receive a beautiful Print of the Year trophy at our January meeting.
