Here are the rules...

Image Size: Longest dimension 4,000 pixels (20 inches at 200 ppi)

Color Profile: sRGB or Adobe 1998

Named as: Image Title.jpg (Sample: New York at Sunrise.jpg)

Must be exact name of Print

Saved as: JPG, quality 10

Total File Size: Not to exceed 3.5 MB

4 Categories: Portrait * Weddings/Events * Illustrative * Artistic (<u>NEW</u>!)

Max Entries: Send up to 6 images!!

Do not use your own name in the file. Remove any keywords added to the EXIF data.

In an email, identify each submission **EXACTLY** as follows: **Last Name,First Name,TITLE,Category**Sample: Smith,Jennifer,NEW YORK AT SUNRISE,Illustrative (no space after commas)
Repeat for each submission. Send images as attachments to the email.

Subject format for email - Month Year Print Comp (Sample: Sep 2019 Print Comp)

DEADLINE: 9:00 A.M. SHARP, MONDAY, JANUARY 13TH - NO EXCEPTIONS!!

Submit early to be safe. ELI will send you a confirmation via email by Tuesday at 6:00 p.m. If you do not receive the email by Wednesday morning, email him <u>immediately</u>.

You must be a member and be present at the meeting for your images to be judged and/or critiqued.

A Message from Our President

Happy New Year to all of you! I hope that your holidays were terrific! Our meeting on January 15 is a Digital Print Competition.

Please note that there is now a new category for entered images! The categories for Print Competition are:

- <u>Portrait</u> Images can portray a subject or subjects from all walks of life and should reflect the personality of the subject(s).
- <u>Wedding / Event</u> Images can portray a subject or subjects from all aspects of a wedding including traditional portraits, candids or detail work.
- <u>Illustrative</u> Capturing the beauty of nature, wildlife, industry, and architectural areas are considered illustrative.
- <u>(New) Artistic</u> The purpose of this competition is to allow the entrant to demonstrate their art skills and expertise. Entries will be judged for digital, artistic, and technical proficiency. Entries can be created using digital or traditional art (such as painting and airbrush) or a combination of both. If multiple images are used, the guide images must be included on the face of the entry.

For the newer members of our group, I'd like to explain a bit about what a print comp is and how it works. First and foremost, print competition is an excellent way to improve your images, composition, and eye for subjects. All images entered are judged and critiqued live at the meeting. The judges have been trained to follow the PPA 12 Elements of a Merit Image: https://www.ppa.com/events/ photo-competitions/ipc-international-photographic-competition-overview/the-12-elements-of-a-merit-image. It's important to consider that there is one other element that is not listed but can be very important to the score of your image. That is the Title; and since the title can enhance or detract from the impact of your image, it can often make or break a merit image. Makers of the image are not announced at the meeting. Only the makers of award-winning images are announced at the end. I can tell you from personal experience that just by listening to the comments of the judges, I have learned a great deal and have improved my photography. I learn just as much by listening to the critiques of other photographer's images as I do from my own; so you do not necessarily have to enter images to benefit.

The rules for submission can be found elsewhere in this newsletter. I will elaborate more about the scoring system for the images at our meeting, but I invite everyone to enter up to six images! Feel free to contact me or any other member with any questions you might have.
