

# Sports Photography




Join Elisa and Al as they present their workflow from start to finish from banner capture to production. They will explain how they

#### BIO:

Al founded 'Photographic *Services,'* a successful photography, graphics and printing business in 1980. Als wife, Elisa joined the business when they married in 1985. With the addition of wide format printing capabilities in 2013, the business expanded into offering sports banners, to both individuals and teams. The banners have been widely accepted especially among senior athletes. In addition to senior athlete banners, high schools have begun asking them to offer them to adknowledge their skills along with the support staff the production requires.



## A Message from Our President

Many thanks go to our judges at last month's Digital Print Competition, Paul Bernstein and Steve Yahr. Their comments offered great insight and opportunities for improving our images and our photography. After the print comp, I emailed my thanks to both Paul and Steve. I also mentioned to them about an image

that I had thought they misinterpreted and how the score they gave it was affected by that. (It was not one of my images.) They each emailed me back with an explanation that was, in itself, a learning experience. I'm paraphrasing the thoughts:

Yes, that occasionally happens. In Print Comps, the judges have a matter of mere seconds to take in the title, look at the image, and give a score. The title is **very important** in this process, as it clues the judges in what to look for. If the title is ambiguous or misleading, the judges may focus on something in the image that the maker never intended as the focus.

The learning that I came away with is that we need to be almost as careful with our title as we are with our image. You never want to leave the meaning of the image up to the minds of the judges. It needs to be very clear... a good piece of knowledge that I thought I'd share with all of you!

Most importantly, they will discuss how they seek out new clients and how to interact with the students, coaches and parents to be asked back. Two leagues have been clients for over 20 years!
